CHARLES CIMICKY Autograph Shiraz Barossa Valley Shiraz 2005

**\$29.50/bottle, or \$28-/bottle- with our cash discount
(sug. price \$45-)**

I have been a fan of this small high quality winery for several years now. We have sold lots of their basic "Trumps" Shiraz which is a perennial favorite. But today we are featuring their high end wine -The "Signature". It is a wine which has gotten consistent 93 points ratings in every year that it's been reviewed.

This wine normally retails for \$45- so when I was offered a one time deal to purchase the latest vintage at a deep discount -I did not have to think much.

The winery was established in 1973 by a Czeck immigrant named Karl Cimicky and by the 1990's the second generation took a strong interest, and the wines soon move up to become truly top notch.

These guys spare no expenses or attention to detail;

From organic practices in the vineyards, to using their own top of the line equipment: the finest presses, fermenters and barrels. Something that most small wineries can't



afford.
to do.

Unlike many Australian wines that can be over the top Cimicky's wines are known for their purity and balance. It's not just beautiful fruit, there is enough stuffing in these wines to bring out the mineral, smoke and earthy elements that will allow them to gain complexity with some bottle age and make these wines so much more than just big fruit bombs.

I will be picking up our order on Monday -Quantities are limited -I will process orders based on the time of your requests -to avoid disappointment please email me your order as soon as you can.

The Wine Advocate review from October 2007: **93 points:** "The 2005 Shiraz "Autograph" spent 17 months in 60% new American oak. The wine is a glass-coating purple with room-filling aromas of cedar, mocha, cocoa, blueberry, and black currant liqueur. This leads to a medium to full-bodied, opulent wine with layers of ripe black and blue fruits, soft tannins, and excellent length. Allow 4-6 years of evolution in the cellar and drink this well-made Shiraz through 2025."
